Dear Customer

On June 24th, U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission announced a 2 million-crib recall involving seven companies including Evenflo, Child Craft and the maker of the Babi Italia line. I wanted to take a moment to provide some additional info on the recall so you are not concerned about the equipment we use.

The crib companies and the number of cribs involved in these recalls are:

- Evenflo, 750,000 Jenny Lind models
- Delta Enterprise Corp., 747,000 drop-side plus every model that uses a wood stabilizer bar
- LaJobi, 306,000
- Million Dollar Baby, 156,000
- Jardine Enterprises, 130,000 sold exclusively by Toys R Us/Babies R Us
- Simmons Juvenile Products Inc., 50,000
- Child Craft, two recalls involving drop-side and stationary side cribs

All of the cribs we use are manufactured by the Delta Enterprise Corp. There are 2 different recalls for Delta; one is for the Lift and Push style drop sides and one is for the Mattress Support Bars (wood stabilizers).

Please note, we do not use any Lift and Push drop side cribs. The problem that was occurring with these is the consumer was installing the lower tracks incorrectly and the drop side came out at the bottom. Again, we do not use these and only use the latch and lock models. So this part of the recall did not apply. The second part of the Delta recall was with the stabilizer bars. This did pertain to the cribs we use. Again the problem was the consumer installing these upside down and not a manufacturing defect. The recall required additional installation instruction to ensure the bars were installed correctly I have reviewed the instruction and have re-reviewed the installation instructions with my delivery guys.
