Dear Customer(s),

On Dec 15, 2010 the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) announced the long awaited ban on the manufacture, sale, and re-sale of drop-side cribs. The new ban, which goes into effect in **June of 2011**, will require that all cribs have fixed sides. This new move will also prohibit hotels and childcare centers from using drop-side cribs, though **those facilities would have two years to purchase new cribs.** I believe that my service falls under this category.

To support this decision we at Crumb Kruncher Rental have already started replacing our drop-side cribs with non drop-side cribs. But we are also going to retain some inventory of drop-side cribs and both models are available for selection on the web site. We will only be able to offer the drop-side cribs for as long as the CPSC allows.

Last June there was one such recall that affected the model crib I use. The recall was specific to the stabilizer bars on the cribs we use. Specifically, the problem was the consumer was installing these bars upside down and was not a manufacturing defect. The recall required additional installation instruction to ensure the bars were installed correctly. I have reviewed the instruction and have re-reviewed the installation instructions with my delivery guys. Here is the link to that recall: <http://www.cribrecallcenter.com/mattress.asp>

I understand the sensitivity to this issue and concern you may have and completely understand if you are not comfortable with the use of a drop-side crib. That is why I've provided this info, to help you understand our plan and allow you to make an informed decision.
